The **Toxicology Training For Prosecutors** is a course designed to equip prosecutors with the tools necessary to handle blood alcohol toxicology evidence in impaired driving cases. The course includes hands-on instruction with the breath testing instruments used for evidentiary testing in Idaho. Topics such as uncertainty measurement, using the standard operating procedures, blood toxicology, discovery issues, motions to suppress and defense challenges will be addressed. Included is a wet lab where prosecutors will be able to explore common defense challenges to evidentiary breath samples.
